

Guidelines for Donations:

Items which can be auctioned on a single basis – i.e. Longaberger baskets, designer accessories, collectibles, arts and crafts such as handmade quilts, wall hangings, knit or crochet items, paintings, woodwork, floral arrangements and handmade jewelry

Gift baskets containing a grouping of related items – i.e. gourmet coffee and tea basket

Gift certificates for merchandise or services – i.e. gift certificates from an attorney, accountant, or styling salon

In order to help our auctioneer, we would greatly appreciate if donations include a brief written description of items. Please see examples below:

Quilt – This is a hand-pierced quilt in the Log Cabin pattern. Its dimensions are 54X74 inches (single size). The fabric is a machine washable, line dry cotton/polyester blend. The quilt was made in Lancaster County by an Amish lady. Her signature is on the reverse side. Value is \$450.00.

Small craft item – This is a lovely handcrafted sterling silver cross pendant. The matching sterling silver herringbone chain is 18” long. Made by a local artist, NAME. Value is \$20.00.

Gift basket – This basket contains an assortment of gourmet teas and coffees, a handmade tea cozy, napkins, and a bone china teapot made in England. Value is \$65.00.

Gift certificate – Financial Planner – This certificate is good for a personal financial analysis. It includes asset allocation, educational funding, debt management, retirement and estate planning. Value is \$400.00.

Gift certificate – hair salon – This certificate is good for one cut, style and blowdry at NAME AND ADDRESS OF SALON. Expiration is one year from date on certificate. Value is \$25.00.
